

Instructions for Mechatronics 2013 paper (style: title)

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Abstract This document gives the instructions for formatting your paper for Mechatronics 2013 conference. The paper should be of minimum 6 and maximum 8 pages long, additional pages are subject of extra charge. Paper must be formatted according to this template. The abstract should be around 100 words (style: abstract)

1 Introduction (style: heading1)

The structure of the paper should meet commonly used standards for conference papers with introduction, materials and methods, discussion/conclusions and proper references. (first paragraph after heading style: p1a)

Margins, column widths, line spacing, and type styles are built-in; examples of the type styles are provided throughout this document. Second and following paragraphs are in style: normal with the first line indent.

1.2 Equations (subheading, style: heading2)

Equations must be written using Microsoft Equation Editor or MathType Editor. Paragraph style for equations: equation. Equations must be numbered, as in following example:

$$a + b = c \tag{1}$$

1.3 Figures

Be careful when annotating figures to keep the figure text readable. Colored figures are allowed. Each figure must be accompanied with numbered caption. Center the figures as in following example:

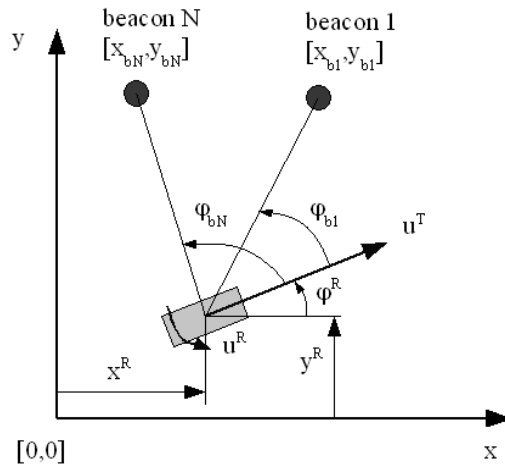


Fig. 1. Sample figure above with the proper caption in style: figlegend.

1.3 Tables

Tables must be numbered and accompanied with proper table title placed above the table. Springer Macro “Format Table” is recommended for table format if applicable.

Table 1. Table title should be placed above the table (style: tablelegend)

2 Conclusions

The conclusions should summarize the essence of the paper, state the advantages compared to other methods, etc.

References in text must be in reference brackets [1]. References list (in style: references) is placed at the end of the paper. Examples of references for book, journal article and conference paper are given below in this document.

Acknowledgments The acknowledgments is applicable should be placed post the conclusion and prior the references. Style: acknowledgements
